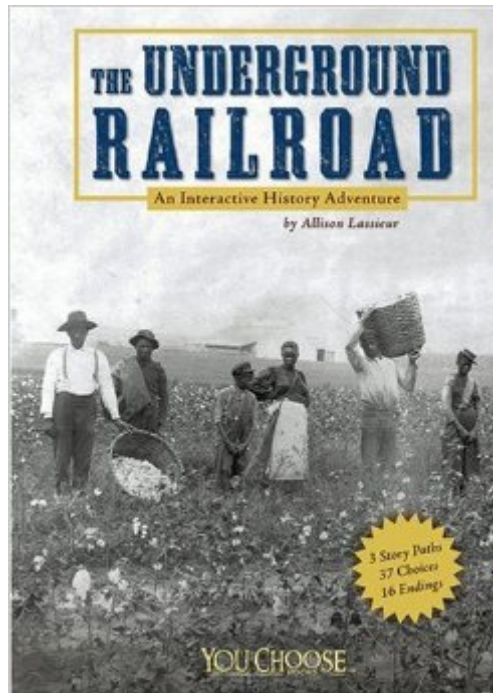

MY fifth graders love these choose your own path books. I read them aloud and then the whole class votes on what the character should do next. After we have finished a path they always beg to go back and read the alternative choice. It is a good way to have fun and learn history.

We have been using many of the interactive history adventures for the last few years at home. Our son loves them. In this book about the Underground Railroad, you get to feel like you're living in those times as each path you choose and take determines what happens next. Each story is true. Students get to experience what it's like to be a runaway slave, a slave catcher, or an abolitionist with the courage to work in sheltering those traveling on their journey to freedom. Overall, it gives many perspectives of an important period in history. Each choice impacts not just that individual but others as well. This book gives a well-rounded view of what life was like for many from several

different backgrounds and it's helpful to see how it all ties in together. This is so much better than just a history lesson that focuses on learning names and dates. More importantly, you get to see these lives intimately and experience (to a degree) what they did in those times.

This is a "choose your own adventure" book. My son learned a lot about slavery in America, and the horrors of being enslaved...in a book suited perfectly for the 7-11 year old child. I highly recommend. He has been through the book several times choosing different scenarios.

I bought this book for include in a unit plan I was writing for a reading course I'm taking as part of a teacher education program. I would definitely use this book in class and I'd like to buy more books in the series. Students can have fun, while learning. As they read through the book, they pick a character and choose a path, then read about that's character's journey. Very cute!
