

My 5 yr old reads this by himself. It has details that are not too complicated for him to understand. He tells me what he read without getting overwhelmed with information. Recommended reading for 5-8 yr olds

I love the whole Step into Reading series. The information is excellent and they are entertaining. The lower levels are long enough that a beginning reader gets a challenge but isn't overwhelmed with length. Level 4 is good for a confident reader, even if they still struggle with sounding words out. Reading comprehension really begins to get exercised at this level.
