

My three year old loves this workbook. Every page reference Star Wars, so if your little one is not familiar with the names of smaller characters from the movies, some pages may be a challenge. The pattern pages (about a quarter of the book) are the most difficult and make the book worth the money. There are also mazes with instructions like follow the black rectangles in a sea of other black shapes. My daughter enjoyed those pages as well. I give it four stars instead of five because there were too many coloring pages for a workbook.

We bought all three workbooks for ages 4-5. My son loves them. We're homeschooling and these work perfectly for our work box system!

My son loves these! It takes learning to a level that kids enjoy rather than something they hate doing. I highly recommend them.
