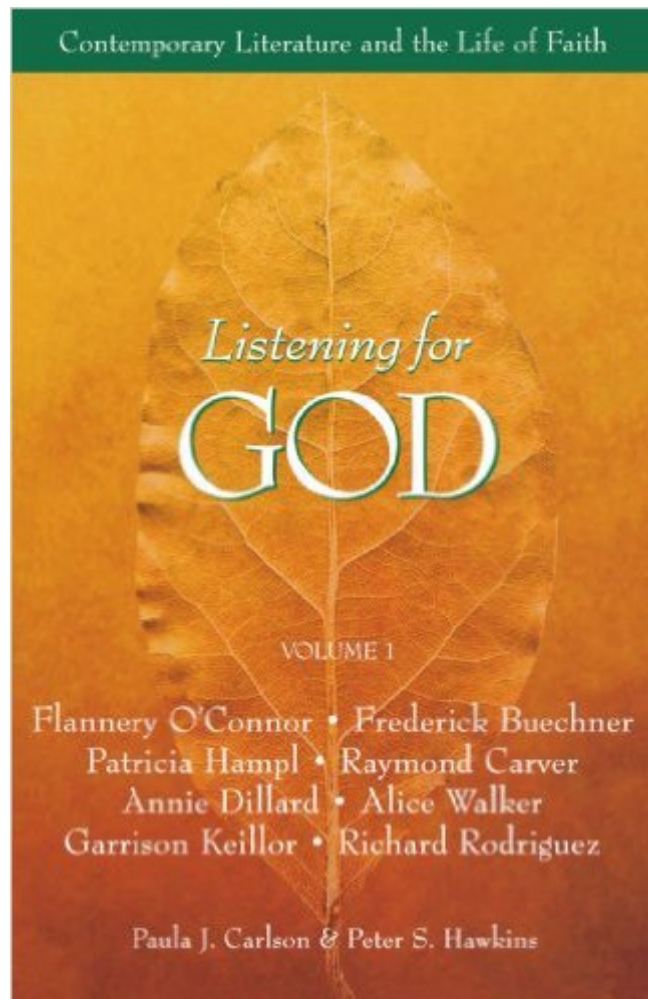

Editors Paula S. Carlson and Peter S. Hawkins have compiled stories and essays from contemporary writers that reflect people's experience in dealing the life events, boredom, crises, losses, disappointments and unexpected touches of grace. Some sections are painful to read and others are funny or joyful (like life itself.) It is interesting that even in our secular society people still ask the questions Job asked and still try to find meaning for themselves like Abraham and Sarah. The editors provide brief bios for the writers and propose discussion questions for groups.that might be helpful in groups. It seems that the problems of being human have not changed greatly in the last few thousand years.

This is a very moving collection of essays for anyone interested in how religious thought affects the writings of authors. I couldn't put the book down and recommend it for discussion groups as well.

With a wide selection of writers, some of whom are not "formally religious people", the editors have provided us with much to prompt our thinking. I have read it several times, gaining personal insight with each reading.

Our group had wonderful discussions on the stories by contemporary authors. Another group will use the book in the fall, and the other group will discuss Volume 2.

I found this mini study of contemporary literature to be very though provoking, and it's prompted me to explore a new core of reading material that I might otherwise not have selected.
