

If you've read an introductory text and have a decent handle on Ruby language basics, definitely pick this up as your second or third book. "Metaprogramming Ruby" sounds exotic, but this is actually fundamental knowledge regarding Ruby's object model and how you can use it. Never again will you wonder about things like, "Why can't I call method X from class Y?"Also, the author gets major points for including all of:- Contrived examples (for learning)- Real-world examples (from Rails and other popular gems / frameworks)- Exercises (for practice)

It's such a concise book that any self taught Ruby programmer would be doing themselves a disservice by not reading this book. It's perfect for advancing your Ruby skills from someone who merely uses Ruby on Rails to someone who can write their own gems like a pro.

Happy to put this on the shelf next to some of my favorite programing/software engineering books. The conciseness with which you can code using skills taught in this book is amazing. I highly recommend this book for programmers that have been using Ruby for a bit and want to learn to harness the best parts of the language.
