

I know that many books contain errors, but the ones in this book made the whole course very frustrating. There are also files to download from the books site that were necessary for the tutorials and programming challenges at the end of the chapters. There were sometimes errors in these files. These can be found at [...]. There are also videos here on some of the tutorials and programming challenges that are helpful in understanding the book. Unfortunately for our class, these problems were compounded because the professor only read from the power

point provided by the author and did not provide much other information beyond this. He also did not help with the errors in the book. There also was much information that was not covered in the previous course that would helped in our understanding of Visual Basic. For these reasons, I have given this book two stars, but could have given it one. So if you are using this book in your course, good luck. I hope your professor will help you work through the errors. I had links to the sites mentioned, but left them blank. To access them, go the the publishers site and look for the links. They are helpful.

But as I read into it, I found that this book raises questions during the text and ask you to solve those questions in the "programming challenge" section. I wanted know the answer but the only way is to get the answer from the "Instructor's Resources". Well, I am not an instructor, I am not taking classes so I am not "cheating" the exam. Why should I be stuck in the middle of nowhere, just because Pearson assumes everyone reading this book is either a student or an instructor?????

This book is a complete waste of time if your teacher hasn't gone through each example to see if the examples were performable in the book itself. This book is the bane of my programming career because it doesn't teach you anything because you have to find workarounds for some of the programs listed in the book. And there's no page for error correcting so if you're stuck, deal with it.

Unlike the last book I purchased from , this one was very worthwhile. I was hardly used and had all the pages. The last book I purchased had every 3rd page torn out of it, answers written in ink, and they were mostly wrong. I know you can't be responsible for every person who sells a used book or anything, but this one actually made up for the last one.

Got sick and could not continue in the course. Hope to use the book and do the work some day. Some not so good conventions in the book, but that might be changed in a future issue. (like not naming things that might not be accessed, but will show up and could confuse someone reading the code)
