

This is a clean, Christian romance. Laurie is a photographer who specializes in portraits of special needs children. Tuck (Kentucky) is a police officer. The story takes place in northern Texas. They meet when Laurie's car is burglarized. Tuck has a nephew with autism and appreciates the work she does. There are more break ins he must deal with and a suspicion that they may be connected. A mystery enfolds and danger increases as does the attraction between protagonists. The Christian thread is light. No preaching whatsoever. Saying "Thank God" or offering to pray for someone is about it. Faith is neither touted nor ignored. The young boy with autism is very well portrayed. The author has either dealt with someone with the condition or has done her research. The attraction between the protagonists seems to take precedence over other aspects of the story (that's not good or bad, just an observance). Editing is well done with very few mistakes (thank you). There are

some logical errors such as swatting a fly in cold January weather and using crutches to walk down a flight of stairs but those issues are in no way a deal breaker. Some people who are decidedly anti-gun may take issue with some of the storyline but I believe in the constitution so I applaud the author with her responsible owner stance. I hope you take the time to read this story. I enjoyed it and I believe you will too.

This book was very well written. Not only did I really like the Christian faith that was brought out in the book, by the characters dealing with every day life, but also that the characters did not forget to remember to place their relationships in God's hands, even through trials.
